We are so proud of all your children and can't wait to see everyone again for face to face teaching and learning again.


World Book Day – 4th March

Our theme for World Book Day this year is:

'Reading gives us someplace to go when we have to stay where we are'


To celebrate our love of reading we have designed many ways we will be celebrating this day whether that be at home or in school.

Each year group have chosen a book to focus on for the day which links to our theme of being transported to different places when we read. This will be read to the children on the day by staff during the morning live learning meeting. Work for the day will be presented as a menu of choice. The idea is that children can pick one item from each section of the menu to complete as their learning. All these will be linked to their year group book. They can then share what they have been doing at the afternoon live meeting and by submitting their work as the daily assignment.



In addition to this, we are inviting the children to dress up to link to our theme when they join in with the Teams meetings or attend school. They can pick a character that they wish they could be transported to meet or an outfit that they would wear to a destination a book can take them too. There is lots of scope to be creative with our theme so please do not go and buy anything special. Just use what you have already. Some simple ideas are:

Shorts/T-shirt/Sun glasses – Where the sea meets the shore
Woolly hat, scarf and gloves – One snowy night
Superhero/Character outfit – Ten little Superheroes



Any character from a book outfit.

Staff would love to see our children dressed up on their live learning meeting in the morning and afternoon if they would like to. This is entirely optional. Children attending school may also dress up if they wish.

We have also organised a special video from Authors Chris Smith and Greg James (Kid Normal books) who have answered some questions that our children have submitted to them. They will also perform a poem they have written during lockdown on the video which we hope your children will enjoy. This will be shared via a youtube link on the day for your child to watch.

Along with the above some staff will be having a go at our own version of 'The Masked Reader'. You child can have fun trying to guess the member of staff dressed up with their face hidden and voice disguised sharing some extracts of their favourite books.

Miss Womack and Miss Greensmith will be starting the day off by sharing an assembly on Teams and all these videos will be shared on Teams for your children to enjoy watching.

As usual all work is to be submitted via the assignments on Teams and we are very much looking forward to sharing some photos of the work the children create in next week's newsletter.

Each child will also be sent an electronic World Book Day voucher token via Teachers 2 Parents. This can be exchanged for a special book in selected shops. All details are on the voucher.

This promises to be an exciting and different style of day that we are all very much looking forward to.

Parent/Teacher meetings

During the week commencing 22nd March 2021, we will be offering all parents the opportunity to speak with their child's class teacher over Teams or the telephone. This will be a chance to talk about learning during lockdown and also a chance to discuss how they have settled back into school again. Each class will be offering different evenings and times and this will be shared in the coming weeks. Booking will be available via email and text message.

Comic Relief

We will be joining in with fundraising for Comic Relief on Friday 19th March 2021. The theme this year is superheroes so we will be inviting the children to dress up as a superhero (either a known one or an invented one) for the day in exchange for an online donation to Comic Relief. For health and safety reasons we will not be wearing red noses on the day but children can wear other comic relief products if they wish such as T-shirts and headwear.
